

**SMITHTOWN CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT
BOARD OF EDUCATION
REGULAR MEETING and PUBLIC HEARING**

February 25, 2014

A. Updates/Awards - the Superintendent updated the Board on the following items of interest:

- Kevin Donaldson and Matthew Uricchio are two Smithtown High School students who take courses at the BOCES Wilson Tech Center and were the victors among 15 Long Island Teams and won about \$45,000 in scholarships for taking first place in a regional automotive competition. The contest is part of the National Automotive Technology Competition developed by the Greater New York Auto Dealers Association.
- The budget process in underway and members of the community are welcome at all meetings. Budget workshops will be held at the Joseph M. Barton Building, 26 New York Avenue, in the auditorium. The next budget workshop will be held on Tuesday, March 4th at 7:00 PM. Please refer to the district website for budget information and a listing of budget workshops.
- Reminder about Transportation – All transportation requests for the 2014-2015 school year for private or parochial school students must be made by April 1, 2014 regardless of

whether the request is for a first-time applicant or is a renewal. If you are a first time applicant, you need to register your child with the Smithtown School District in order to be considered for transportation, receive textbooks and/or other educational services. Registration must occur in person and will take place at 26 New York Avenue until the April 1st deadline.
