- The District is continuing to monitor class sizes. The sections of Mt. Pleasant kindergarten will remain at five. The sections at St. James that were on the cusp are remaining at four. As a point of clarification in response to a letter in a local newspaper we are lowering the class cap in grade three, and grade three only, to 26. The class cap averages for grades four and five are still at 27.
