**OPENING CEREMONY** - conducted by Mr. Gianino. On motion by Mr. Saggese, seconded by Mr. Rossi, the Board voted unanimously to convene in Executive Session to discuss Particular Personnel, Negotiations and Litigation.

At 8:04 p.m. Mrs. Waldron moved, Mr. Raustiala seconded, and the Board reconvened the Regular Meeting. In recognition of 9/11 the HS East Chamber Choir and the HS West Jazz Choir, led by Mr. Mark Hegreness and Ms. Lynn Oill, sang The Star Spangled Banner. Mr. Gianino, on behalf of the Board, thanked the students and their teachers for their fine performance.

### **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

#### Facilities

Mr. Raustiala reported that there will be a Facilities Committee Meeting on Monday, October 1<sup>st</sup> at 7:30 p.m.

Mr. Rossi noted that the District had received a comprehensive plan update from the Town of Smithtown. He suggested that a copy of the update be kept in the District Clerk's Office for public viewing.

Mr. Rossi requested that a Facilities Committee Meeting be scheduled in the near future. No date was decided upon.

#### Legislative

Mrs. Waldron reported that Suffolk County Legislator Kennedy has suggested that the Board request the Superintendent send a letter to Mr. Joe Williams, Commissioner of Suffolk County Fire Rescue and Emergency Services (SCFRES). A Suffolk County Disaster Mitigation Plan is being filed in draft form by SCFRES and SEMO, which is the State Emergency Management Organization. There is a deadline of September 30<sup>th</sup> for the plan which will be sent to FEMA. Mr. Kennedy explained that it is a "condition precedent" for FEMA disaster funding. Mr. Kennedy asked that the District list separately the weekly pumping cost for the sewage problem at Branch Brook and the possible ongoing humidity and potential leakage at Smithtown Elementary. The District may be able to recoup some of the money it is spending on these water problems. The Board gave their permission for the Superintendent to send such a letter to the Commissioner.

### **SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT**

Updates – The Superintendent brought the Board up-to-date on the following items:

- Smithtown's schools had a smooth opening last week as we welcomed more than 11,000 students in grades K-12 to the 2007-2008 school year. Thank you to our administrators, teachers, transportation, custodial, buildings and grounds and clerical workers for a job well done.
- Our schools held various ceremonies to commemorate the events of September 11, 2001. Students observed the anniversary with moments of silence and reflection, the reading of appropriate poetry, and the singing of patriotic songs. Students honored those who lost their lives as well as the many heroes who rose to the occasion on that day.
- This is the first Board of Education meeting that will be pod cast on the Smithtown School District website: [www.smithtown.k12.n.y.us](http://www.smithtown.k12.n.y.us). In conjunction with the radio clubs of High School East and High School West, our technology department under the leadership of John Nolan, will be mentoring students to broadcast the audio portion of meetings on our website.
- The preliminary report on the Branch Brook septic system has been submitted to the Suffolk County Department of Health and has been reviewed. As a result, the final set of drawings has been submitted to Suffolk County for approval.
- The Homecoming Parade will be held Saturday, September 29<sup>th</sup> at 11:00 am. The parade will begin at St. Patrick's School parking lot and will proceed down Main Street. The High School West football game will be Friday, Sept. 28<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 pm and the High School East football game will be held Saturday, Sept. 29<sup>th</sup> at 1:30 pm.
- *Penumbra 2007*, SHS West's literary magazine, has won a Silver Medal from the Columbia University Scholastic Press Association.
- Ray Preston, an Accomsett Middle School teacher, along with Chuck Dennis and Rob Warner, two Nesaquake Middle school teachers, were chosen to participate in the Northrop-Grumman Zero Gravity program. Yesterday, a Boeing 767, filled with 20 teachers from various districts, took off and spent two hours in the air, riding up and down in order for the teachers to experience zero gravity. The teachers engaged in various activities, including zero gravity pushups, and performed 16 experiments during the two hour flight.
- The Smithtown School District has embarked on a Global Education curriculum initiative to help foster global awareness about the living conditions of children in other parts of the world. The project involves a fundraising effort to drill a clean water well in a remote village in Tanzania.
- Nesconset Elementary School will be taking part in the "Get a Voice" Project as part of its Character Education Program during this school year. This is a collaborative effort between the faculty and the PTA.
- The Smithtown-Cortland Scholarship Committee plans to award the first \$1,000 scholarship in June 2008 to a Smithtown senior who is going to attend SUNY Cortland. This is the first time a scholarship has been established by school district employees and retirees for a student to attend Cortland.
