Facilities- Mrs. Waldron reported that she, Mr. Alcure, Ms. McEnroy, Dr. Grossane, Jennifer Bradshaw, Andrew Tobin , Don Wallace and Dan Leddy took a tour last Friday of several of our buildings to review some of the capital projects completed over the summer.

VII. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

A. Updates-

- Parent Portal- this year the website and the Parent Portal functioned without any glitches and parents were able to successfully access their child's placement information on the portal.
- Negotiations- Tonight the Board will be voting on a Memorandum of Agreement with the STA. Currently four out of the five bargaining unit contracts are now settled.
- High School West- was named one of Newsweek's top high schools coming in at number 231. Congratulations to High School West.
- Sale of NYA- over the past year the Board has been meeting with several developers as potential buyers for the NYA property. Negotiations have begun to enter into a contract with one of those developers. A contract should be ready for Board approval soon at which time more details will be available. Once the district has entered into a contract for sale, the approval and variance process then shifts to the town. Closing on the sale would be roughly 3 to 3^{1/2} years from the signing of the contract.

- Enrollment- opening day enrollment for elementary was 3626, compared to 3750 last year. Kindergarten enrollment is 481, compared to 534 last year. We graduated 843 students in 2016. Dr. Grossane reviewed the projected class sizes and number of empty classroom for 2017-2018. A complete list of all this information will be available on the district website.
